BabyPD (3) Abs: 1

1st: Young's, Leyenda's Be Dazzled. 5-month, Cobby brindle of good size for age, a typical masculine head, correct lip placement good mouth and dentition, head developing well, open nostrils, dark eyes, decent stop and rise of skull to excellent ear placement and size used to give alert expression on the move. Arched neck of good length to particularly good shoulders, straight front developing strong bone and musculation, chest off decent depth with sprung and layback of ribs to short loin. Rear quarters developing well showing second thigh. Topline and tailset with correct shaped roach over loin. Moved very well for his age settled down quickly.

2nd Banks, Leyenda Mr Tumble, 5-month fawn, litter brother to 1st not the head of 1st broad with good padding, mouth and dentition developing well, deep stop between dark well-placed eyes of decent shape and size. Strong neck to developing straight front assembly, chest with good heart room and well sprung ribs to correct tuck up under broad loin. Rear quarters coming on well showing good second thigh already and well let down hocks not quite as put together on the move as 1st but moved okay.

BPB (2) Abs: 0

1st & BBabyPuppy Foley's leyenda's Par Te Time Rebel. 4months, Fawn, lovely compact bitch with balance head and body in profile already showing future promise at this age. Balanced feminine head with obvious chin, mouth showing correct lip placement good dentition at this stage, open nostrils to deep stop between nice dark eyes, clean head with correct rise to ears of decent size and shape placed well and used well to keep alert playful expression. Arched neck to straight front assembly with good bone and tight feet. Chest and spring of ribs developing well with correct tuck up to short broad loin. Rear quarter coming along nicely with developing second thigh. Front and rear angulation already showing correct construction. Moved with drive when settled.

2nd Hucker's, Bevanray Asparagus, 5-month fawn, nice in outline, head broad with well-padded muzzle, nice lip placement, open nostrils deep stop between well shaped eyes, skull rising to ears well placed of correct shape. Strong neck to decent front assembly correct topline and tailset. Chest and ribs developing well to short broad loin. Rear quarters muscling up well moved okay when settled.

DOGS

MPD (1 Entries) Abs: 0 1st: Cole's Myntie Pure Magic. Brindle strong head and body, nice broad head developing well, good lip placement, dark open nostrils, deep stop, dark expressive eyes, ears of balanced size. Muscled neck with good layback of shoulders, straight front & tight feet, chest and rib cage developing well to short broad loin. Rear quarters also developing decent musculation and second thigh. Front and rear movement not quite coordinated at this time handler needs to find right pace. Still the puppy needing time to settle for his handler.

PD (5 Entries) Abs: 1 1st: & BPIS, Bonsall's, Bestfrenchie Pirat at Muggshotts, pied with clean masculine head, nice depth of chin, well padded muzzle and broad open nostrils, deep stop to broad clean skull, correct shape and size of ears used well to show alertness. Muscular neck of decent length to correct topline and tailset, with good shoulder placement and straight front assembly with sound bone, pasterns and tight feet. Developing deep chest and well sprung ribs, broad muscled loin, rear quarters firming up well showing good second thigh and well let down hocks. Moved well with some drive and reach around the ring.

2nd: Membury's Membully Razzale Dazzle JW. Fawn, strong masculine head, broad good mouth, open nostrils, deep stop to rise of skull, well placed ears of good size giving alert expression. Muscular neck to correct topline with gentle roach over broad loin to correct tailset. Generally balanced in outline with decent musculation and angulation, straight front with solid bone and upright pasterns. Moved well.

3rd: Hanslow's Kiankang Adonis Burenperro Res: Smith's Membully Razzmatazz at Ellouab, 2 JD (5 Entries) Abs: 0 1st DCC & RBIS: Smith's, Khanin Gunner Make It, brindle, Excellent in outline with no exaggeration, lovely balanced masculine head, nicely padded muzzle showing good depth and width of lower jaw with obvious chin and correct lip placement, broad open nostrils with deep stop leading to dark expressive eyes, broad clean skull with ears of good size and placement used to show alert expression. Balanced body, muscular neck to well laid-back shoulders, a straight front with sound bone, deep chest, and spring of ribs to correct tuck up under muscled loin, very sound rear quarters and correct second thigh with well let down hocks. Moved very well keeping his shape and topline with reach and drive.

2nd: McGroarty's, Caslblaks Maxi Jazz Ardhub (naf) dark bridle male with a nice broad masculine head. Mouth and dentition correct with good chin and lip placement, open nostrils to deep stop to clean rise of skull with ears carried well and used to give alert expression. Body very balanced in outline with good front and rear angulation, arched muscular neck to correct topline and tail set with gentle roach over broad muscled loin. Deep chest with well sprung ribs rear quarter muscular showing good second thigh and let down hocks. Moved very well today.

3rd: Roach's, Roalice Master Mouse.

Res: Ross's Franstelgos Low Rider.

BYD (6 Entries) Abs: 0 1st: Brooks, Serenant Maverick. Dark Brindle with balanced head and compact body, mouth with broad lower jaw with evident chin and correct dentition. Well padded muzzle broad open nostrils, deep stop to dark eyes and clean rise of skull to ears of decent size, used to give constant alert expression. Muscled neck to topline with nice rise over muscular loin to correct tailset. Good front assembly straight with sound bone and upright pasterns. Deep chest and well sprung ribs with good layback to loin. Rear quarters well muscled with good second thigh. Moved with well on the day, presented in excellent condition.

2nd: Roach's Roalice Major Mouse, Brindle, well muscled throughout and balanced both in head and body. Masculine head with correct mouth and dentition. Padded muzzle, broad open nostrils and deep stop to dark eyes of correct shape and size. Rise of clean skull to ears of good size and placement. Strong neck, sound straight front, deep chest with sprung ribs to short loin. Rear quarters developing good muscle, showing noticeable second thigh, moved well. 3rd: Suhareva, Castrum Osinium Roller Coaster at Avermayz, Res: Jordan's, Rowanpaws Comet Star.

ND (2 Entries) Abs: 0 1st: Kelly's Xandene New You Were Smart with Casemates. Pied, balanced in both head and cobby body. Atypical masculine head, broad lower jaw with good dentition, well padded muzzle, black open nostrils well padded under dark eyes, deep stop and rise to clean skull, ears of decent shape and size, very attentive. Strong neck to correct top line and tailset with rise over broad muscular loin. Correct shoulder placement straight front with sound bone upright pasterns and tight feet. Deep chest to well sprung ribs and good tuck up to, muscled rear quarters and well let down hocks, moved well.

GD (1 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: Korenna's. Onnis Of My Sweet Moments. Fawn compact, with balanced atypical masculine head, well padded muzzle, correct mouth, and dentition. Deep stop between well shaped eyes of correct size and placement. Medium length muscular neck to good top line and tailset. sound front with upright pasterns, deep chest, and well sprung ribs to short broad loin. Rear quarters muscular with defined second thigh and let down hocks. Moved well on the day.

PGD (2 Entries) Abs: 0 1st Walton & Jones's Ravendane Popeye. Brindle shown in very good condition, Balanced masculine head with correct lip placement, well padded muzzle, open nostrils, deep stop to dark expressive eyes and rise of clean skull. Excellent ear carriage well placed of good size and shape, medium length muscled neck to short cobby body with correct topline and tailset. Balanced front and rear assembly well muscled with sound bone. Moved very well. 2nd: Vearncombe & Hale's Ruptions Knightcott Back To Black JW. Another balanced brindle male. Broad masculine head with good mouth and large open nostrils, well padded muzzle, deep stop, dark well shaped eyes. Good ear carriage of correct size and shape, strong neck, sound front assembly and correct topline and tailset, deep chest and correct layback of ribs to short, muscled loin. Rear quarters well muscled showing good second thigh and well let down hocks, not the mover of 1st today, no doubt these positions will change regularly in the future.

LD (7 Entries) Abs: 1

1st Hutchinson's Zorro of Shine Treasure for Oschalben JW. Double hooded Pied, strong balanced masculine head, broad lower jaw with correct lip placement good dentition. Dark

large nostrils deep stop to dark well shaped dark eyes, clean skull with correct ears placed well and used to give alert expression. Muscular neck to correct topline and tailset, front assembly straight, strong with solid bone and upright pasterns, deep chest and well sprung ribs to short broad loin. Balanced front and rear angulation allowed him to move very well today.

2nd Walton & Jones's Vanystone Born To Love. Brindle male with excellent balanced cobby body. Atypical broad head with correct lip placement and good dentition, wide open nostrils, well padded muzzle to deep stop between dark eyes of correct size and shape. Rise to clean skull to correct ears. Muscular neck to balanced, straight, sound front assembly, chest and ribs well aligned to give plenty of heart room to short, muscled loin. Balanced angulation should have had the dog moving well, but today was not the mover of one.

3RD Morison's, Xandene Knew You Were Magic.

Res: Forsythe's, Chivasregal Innes Of Islam Ardhub.

VHC: Hucker's, Bevanray Terrypendry JW.

OD (6 Entries) Abs: 0

1st & RDCC: Cund & Harrop's. CH/EspCH. Chelmbull Rocket Man WW exceptional compact brindle with no exaggerations, balanced head and body looking square in outline. Head: Defined chin with broad lower jaw, correct lip placement black open nostrils, well padded muzzle, deep stop between eyes of correct size and shape rise to clean skull ears of balanced size and position used to keep alert expression on the move, strong neck of medium length to spot on topline and tailset with gentle roach over muscular loin. Front and rear assemblies balance each other out allowing good reach and drive on the move no matter the pace. Strong straight front with upright pasterns and tight feet. Deep broad chest with well sprung ribs and tuck up to the loin and rear quarters which are well muscled showing correct angulation and second thigh moved really well today. Very close for the CC.

2nd Timms, Olijah Cut To The Chase JW, OSW. Another excellent brindle, a little taller than one but does not lose the balanced look in the head and body, broad lower jaw showing defined chin good mouth and lip placement, padded muzzle, broad, black, open nostrils, deep stop, eyes well shaped dark and expressive. Ear carriage good for size and placement, arched neck to correct topline and tailset, correct front assembly straight front with good bone and upright pasterns. Deep chest and sprung ribs lead to short muscular loin and rear muscled quarters showing correct second thigh development. Moved with drive.

3rd Brooks & Cairns Corursus Become The One JW. OSW.

Res. Bonsall & Odendaal, CH Muggshots Whiz Bang Wilber.

VHC: Coffey, Raglenary Jack Frost. Ir JCH.

VD (2 Entries) Abs (0)

1st BVIS Timms, CH/Ir/IntCH Eastonite Maui JW. ShCM ShCEX 7yr old Excellent Fawn who has retained his clean head and athletic body, balanced in both head and body in outline. Muzzle well padded, correct lip placement with defined chin, open nostrils, deep stop between dark expressive eyes, black mask showing a little grey round the edges. Rise to clean skull with well placed ears of correct shape and size, arched neck to correct layback of shoulders over strong straight front with sound bone. Chest deep with well sprung ribs, good tuck up under broad

muscled loin. Topline correct with gentle roach over the loin to correct tailset. Muscled rear quarters with sufficient angulation and obvious second thigh and let down hocks. Move with easy reach and drive, presented in good condition.

2nd Kasprovicz's Pol. CH Daniello Easter Power Live JW, ShCM. Older fawn at 9.5yrs Large masculine head broad under jaw with good lip placement, well padded muzzle large black nose with open nostrils, deep stop to dark very expressive eyes, rise of skull to decent size ears well placed. Strong broad neck leading to topline with slight roach over loin and correct tailset. Front assembly is strong with good bone. Very deep and broad chest and spring of ribs with good tuck up to loin and muscular rear quarters. Unfortunately, age and the long wait caught up on this lovely older dog who was not inclined today to move very well for his owner.

1st Hutchinson's Zorro Of Shine Treasure for Oschalben JW

SOFD (3 Entries) Abs: 0

1st Morrison's Xandene All That's Magic, Strong masculine head, good mouth and lip placement, black mask, open nostrils, deep stop, eyes of correct shape and size, broad head and well shaped ears, muscular neck compact body with correct topline and tailset with rise over the short broad loin. Front assembly straight, sturdy with sound bone, deep chest, and well sprung ribs to tuck up under muscular loin. Rear quarters well muscled with good angulation and let down hocks. Moved with easy drive.

2nd Jordan's, Rowanpaws Comet Star. Compact with plenty of size and substance, atypical masculine head with well padded muzzle, deep stop with rise to well placed ears of correct shape and size. Muscular neck to straight front assembly, sound bone, and upright pasterns. Balanced front and rear angulation short, muscled loin to developed rear quarters. Not the mover of 1st today.

3rd Korenna's. Onnis Of My Sweet Moments.

SOBD (6 Entries) Abs: 0

1ST Morrison's Rozeldogue Knew It Was You Xandene. Sound, balanced, with very well put together head, mouth with good lip placement and chin with correct upsweep of lower jaw, well padded muzzle, and black nose with open nostrils, deep stop, dark eyes and rise to clean skull of good width, ear carriage and shape correct and of decent size used well to show expression. Neck of medium length and muscled, sound front assembly with decent shoulder placement, topline and tailset correct showing nice rise over the loin. Deep chest correct ribs and tuck up to muscular rear quarters with an obvious second thigh. Moved with drive around the ring.

2nd CUND's Chelmbull Space Man. Another well balanced male, broad masculine head with correct broad lower jaw and obvious chin, dark nose with open nostrils deep stop between expressive eyes of decent shape and placement. Rise to clean skull giving correct width between ears of good size and shape well used to show alert expression. Muscular neck to correct topline and tailset with gentle roach over broad loin. Straight sound front, rear muscular quarters and second thigh, balanced angulation allowing the dog to move well.

BITCHES

MPB (2 Entries) Abs: 0 1st: Hutchinson's. Gailbulls Miss Gabrielle for Oschalben. Clean brindle double hooded pied, excellent compact body, feminine head, padded muzzle, large black nose with open nostrils. Deep stop between dark expressive eyes to rise of clean skull, ears of correct size and shape used well when alert. Neck of medium length to particularly good topline and tail set, cobby in outline with nicely developing straight front with sound bone, well sprung ribs to short broad loin. Rear quarters developing showing defined second thigh. Moved very well for her age.

PB (2Entries) Abs:0 1st: Westmorland's, Gailbulls It's Edith, another lovely brindle pied, litter sister to winner of MPB, very much the same comments as her sister. A little more put together, excellent feminine head with the same dark expressive eyes with correct lip placement, padded muzzle, and deep stop. Ears of decent shape and size and well spaced, strong neck of medium length. Decent shoulder placement to developing straight front assembly with sound bone and tight feet, chest developing well with good length of brisket, well sprung ribs to short broad muscular loin. Rear quarters already developing good, muscular thighs of good width and defined second thigh, correct front, and rear angulation to let down hocks. Moved well for her age. 2nd: Cole's Membully Bedazzled with Myntie. Fawn, a little longer than 1st nice feminine head with well shaped dark eyes, good mouth and dentition and well-padded muzzle of decent length and width. Black nose with open nostrils, ears well placed and pleasing shape, neck to developing front assembly with straight sound bone. Topline and tailset okay, sprung ribs to muscled loin, rear quarters gaining good musculation with obvious developing second thigh. Not the balance on the move as 1st.

3rd Hucker's Bestfrenchie Henia at Bevanray.

Res. Hendry's Castleallen Rising Star IKC.

JB (5 Entries) Abs:0 1st & RBCC TIMM'S, Olijah Fully Loaded JW. Brindle, sound and balanced in outline, lovely feminine head, broad lower jaw, correct lip placement and dentition, with well-padded muzzle, nostril dark and open, deep stop to rise of clean skull, dark eyes correct shape and size. Well placed ear carriage of correct shape and size used to show alert expression. Arched neck to correct topline and tailset, straight front with sound bone upright pasterns and tight feet. Deep Chest with well sprung ribs with decent tuck up to short muscular loin, rear quarters muscled with defined second thigh and well let down hocks. Moved with drive and handled well. 2nd: ROACH, Miss L. Roalice Mega Mouse. Balanced brindle. Not quite the outline of 1st clean feminine head with expressive dark eyes, with ears of decent shape and size giving good expression. Neck of medium length to correct topline, and tailset kept well on the move. Sound straight front deep chest well sprung ribs to broad muscular loin. Rear quarters muscled with good width and defined second thigh and let down hocks. Moved well. 3rd: Jordan, Rowanpaws Love Me Like You Do. Res: Walton & Jones. Ravendane Olive Oil. VHC: Ross, Franstelgos No Action.

YB (9 Entries) Abs:1

1st Tonkin, Pellow & Pellow Rosanyos Let's Salsa Compact fawn, nice feminine head with good mouth and chin, padded muzzle of good width and dark expressive eyes of correct shape and size with well placed ear carriage giving effective use in expression, muscular neck to decent topline and tailset. Strong, straight, sound front assembly with upright pasterns and tight feet. Well sprung ribs to broad loin, muscular rear quarters showing good angulation and well let down hocks. Moved with easy reach and drive.

2nd ROACH, Miss L. Roalice Maxi Mouse. Brindle with feminine head. Broad lower jaw with correct mouth and dentition, padded muzzle, deep stop and dark expressive eyes. Rise of skull to excellent ear carriage, shape, and size, used very well to show alertness. Strong neck to straight front with good layback of shoulders, sound bone with upright pasterns, deep chest, and well sprung ribs to short broad loin. Rear quarters muscular with defined second thigh, balanced angulation with the front, moved well.

3rd Korennaja's Wildax Rowandale Christmas Pudding.

Res. Brooks Serenant Iron Butterfly.

VHC: Vearncombe & Hale's Castrum Osinium ria for Ruptions (imp HRV)

NB (5 Entries) Abs: 0.

1st Foley's, Leyenda's On A Mission. Smaller brindle, lovely feminine balanced head with expressive dark eyes, padded muzzle, and open nostrils. Rise to decent size ears placed correctly to give alert expression, muscled neck to correct topline and tailset, broad loin strong straight front with sound bone, deep chest, and good layback of ribs. Rear quarters muscular with good width and second thigh. Balanced angulation front and rear giving ease of drive on the move.

2nd Sharp-Dixon & Reyes, Queenslake Ready To Rumble. Brindle, balanced feminine head, mouth and dentition okay, broad well-padded muzzle, large open nostrils, deep stop between dark eyes. Ears carried well, muscled neck of medium length to topline and tailset with gentle rise over loin. Balanced front and rear angulation on strong muscular legs with sound bone, moved well today

3rd Hendry's, Castleallen Rising Star IKC.

Res. Thornton's, Zimblistic Oh It's Magic.

VHC. Curran's, Rivers Lucky Seven.

GB (2 Entries) Abs: 0

1st Thornton's, Onlyfrenchie Etna Zimblistic.

Fawn, Nice in outline feminine head with expressive eyes, good mouth and dentition dark open nostrils. Muzzle broad of correct length to deep stop and rise to broad skull and decent ear shape and size carried well always alert. Moderate neck to okay topline and tailset over broad muscled loin. Strong straight front assembly with sound bone and upright pasterns. Chest and ribs to decent tuck up and rear quarters muscular and angulated with well let down hocks giving her drive on the move

2nd Kasprowicz, You Never Know Daniello.

Another fawn this one very good in outline, atypical feminine head with good mouth and dentition, a little narrower in muzzle than 1st dark eyes showing plenty of expression in conjunction with correct ear carriage, muscled neck and strong straight front assembly, sound in bone with deep broad chest, well sprung ribs to tuck up under muscular loin, rear quarters in good muscled condition showing correct second thigh. Moved well.

PGB (6 Entries) Abs:1

1st: BRYANT, Miss V Archness The Vivacious. Fawn well balanced in outline, good size. Pleasing feminine head, black mask, with well padded muzzle, with broad lower jaw and good lip placement, deep stop, expressive dark eyes of attractive shape and size, well placed ear carriage, used to show an alert expression. Strong neck of medium length, sound straight front assembly with good bone and tight feet, deep chest and well sprung ribs, with good tuck up under broad firm loin, well developed muscular rear quarters with good angulation. Moved very well.

2nd: Eskrett's Katakia's Light The Way, JW. Dark brindle with lovely feminine head, dark expressive eyes, deep stop and good rise of skull, well placed ear carriage used to give good expression. Clean, strong neck to decent shoulder placement, correct top line and tailset with nice roach over broad loin. Straight front assembly with good bone, upright pasterns and tight feet, deep chest to well sprung ribs, balanced rear quarters with defined second thigh, moved well.

3rd: Membury's Membully Maybe My Time.

Res: Vearncombe & Hale's, Ruptions Knightcott Back To Black.

VHC: Thornton's Onlyfrenchie Etna Zimblistic.

LB (7 Entries) Abs: 2

1st: HICKIN's Boule & Onuba Dreamgirl (imp Esp) presented in particularly good condition, excellent clean feminine head, dark expressive eyes, correct mouth, dentition and lip placement, well-padded muzzle, good stop and rise of clean skull, to well placed ear carriage, nice size and shape, used to give good expression. Arched neck to decent top line and tailset with nice roach over broad well muscled loin. Correct shoulder placement and straight front assembly with sound bone, upright pasterns and tight feet, deep chest, well sprung ribs with tuck up to short loin, good rear angulation, moved very well holding her topline on the move.

2nd: Ayriss. Lady Rebellion at Boulevaya Brindle, presented in good condition, clean feminine head, with dark expressive eyes, padded muzzle and correct mouth, deep stop and rise to clean broad skull. Ears of balanced size and shape used well to give alert expression. Clean arched neck, correct shoulder placement and front assembly with correct bone, upright pasterns, deep chest, and well sprung ribs with decent layback, to good tuck up. Broad muscular rear quarters good angulation well let down hocks moved well.

3rd: Eskrett's Katakia's Light The Way, JW. Res: Suhareva. Bankholt Indian Summer at Avermayz.

OB (8 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: BCC & BIS, Cund's Chelmbull Eternal Flame. Excellent compact brindle, Balanced and sharp in outline, lovely clean feminine head with no exaggerated points, good mouth, and dentition, showing obvious chin, padded muzzle, large open nostrils, deep stop, with soft dark expressive eyes, clean rise to broad skull, well placed ear carriage of good size and shape, used well to give alert expression. Crisp elegant neck to good layback of shoulders and straight front assembly, with sound bone, tight feet and upright pasterns. Deep chest with well sprung ribs and correct lay back to good tuck up and short broad loin. Obvious well muscled rear quarters

and second thigh with good angulation and let down hocks. moved very well, with drive and reach.

2nd: Wildman & Davis's Wildax Rowendale Meatball Molly Another excellent brindle, lovely feminine head with much of the attributes of 1st. Clean head with good mouth and dentition, padded muzzle, deep stop and dark eyes, clean rise of skull, ears of good size and shape carried well, used very well to show alert expression. Body very much as 1st, balanced and sharp in outline, with excellent front, with deep chest, well sprung ribs to short muscular loin, rear quarters muscular and well formed. Moved well.

3rd: Tonkin, Pellow & Pellow. CH. Rosanyos Sevillana JW.

Res Membury & Pearce, CH. Bullhawks Egg's Citing at Membully.

VB (5 Entries) Abs: 4

1st: Bearley's Kaybull Lamzone. Double Hooded Pied An older lady presented in exceptionally good condition. Atypical feminine head with padded muzzle, and large black open nostrils.
