BABY PUPPY DOG

1st Mrs & Mrs C & J Jordan and Davis's - Rowanpaws Royal Mint.

4 month old brindle baby, coming along as I would like at this age. Clean head with soft wrinkling, well set bat ears and round dark eyes, good padding to square muzzle with good lip placement. He has a clean neck leading to good shoulder placement, ribs developing nicely, good top line with low set tail and correct rear. Moved out steady and for one so young. best baby puppy.

2nd Mr & Mrs T & T Membury's - Membully Stray Bullet. Another promising baby with beautiful head properties. Shorter in loin than 1. He has plenty of bone standing on strong pasterns and good feet with desired dark pigmentation throughout. Good spring of rib and depth of chest. Strong rear with good turn of stifle, plenty thigh and low set hocks.

BABY PUPPY BITCH

1st Mr & Mrs T & T Membury's - Membully Meaner Than Evil.

Brindle bitch of 5 months, beautiful head properties with correct bat ears used to advantage, soft wrinkling to forehead and the softest dark round eyes. Super nostrils with square muzzle, clean well placed lips and lovely under jaw. Enough neck onto good shoulders, straight well boned front and tight feet. Held her top line well on the move displaying good tail set and steady flowing movement. Another promising youngster.

2nd Ms K Thornton's - Zimblistic Ms Grace.

Brindle baby with head developing well, good ear set and clean head properties. Straight front with enough substance throughout. Pleasing in outline and coming together nicely on the move.

Good luck to all with your babies in the future, I will watch with interest.

What a smart little man to start my day with. 8 month old brindle who's so well balanced and in lovely condition throughout. He's very easy on the eye in profile and on the go around really caught my eye.

He has wonderful head properties with his well placed bat ears that he uses to advantage, wonderful dark round eyes, square muzzle with infill coming in nicely and enough cushioning to well placed lips. Clean neck great fore-chest and good spring of rib allowing for plenty heart and

lung room. Straight well boned front standing on good feet. Pleasing topline and good low set tail. His rear is developing well with good angulation which aided this boys free flowing movement and at one with his handler. Shown in nice condition with a gleaming coat. A credit to his handler. RCC & BPIB.

2nd Miss, Mr & Mr Y R & K Tomkin, Pellow & Pellow's - Damada Plinio (Imp ITA) (naf,taf)

6 month old brindle male of nice size and substance. Dark round eyes and enough under jaw. Good length to neck, straight well boned front but would prefer neater feet. Ribbing coming along well that is deep and well sprung. Low set tail. Just needs to come together on the move.

PUPPY DOG

1st Miss S Suhareva & Mr J Cruttenden's - Castrum Osinium No Limit For Avermayz (imp Hrv)

9 month old brindle little showman full of the attitude I love. A square boy who moves out well with plenty of promise. Pleasing head proportions with well set ears used to advantage, dark round eyes and good lip placement. Strong neck, good well sprung ribs and nice length to loin. Good in thigh and hocks set low. Moved well coming and going.

2nd Ms K Thornton's Zimblistic Elgon.

10 month old brindle male full of qualities I look for, he is clean and with no exaggerations throughout. Clean head with well placed ears, soft wrinkling to domed forehead, well placed dark round eyes and square muzzle with clean lips framing a good under jaw. Strong neck set on well laid shoulders, straight front and the tightest of feet. Good depth and chest of rib, lovely desired topline and good tail set. Moves out well, just wished he would make use of himself and sparkle as he should. Improved in a later class maybe once warmed up!

He is well angulated front and rear enabling his free flowing movement held together by pleasing body conditioning.

2nd Mrs, Mr & Mr D S & E Plominska, Kil & Kil's - Narcyz Z Lipkowego Rancza at Bestfrenchie (Imp POL)

Pied male with a very handsome head. He is good for bone and substance. Nice front quarters with straight front, nice feet and good ribbing. I would like him cleaner over his shoulders, good tail and placement. Good underline and moved out well.

YEARLING DOG

1st Ms M Persson - Al Capone Of The Royal Way

A brindle male who is a real showman, with an aura of importance about him. A heavier style for my personal preference but all of the right qualities in the right places. Super handsome head

that is beautifully balanced of correct proportions with lovely dark round eyes and excellent bat ears which he used to advantage. Excellent forechest with good depth of brisket and well sprung ribs. Lovely front with tight feet showing good angulation both front & rear. moved very soundly. There's a lot to like about this boy.

2nd Mr & Mrs T & T Membury's Membully Razzle Dazzle JW

Another nice male with lots of qualities. Fawn with very pleasing head piece displaying all the desired qualities. Square with a flat skull and gentle wrinkling, bat ears used at all times, nice round eyes and strong underjaw. Enough neck leading onto good shoulders and a body that is well developed and pleasing in profile. excellent rib, nice taper to loin with correct topline. Shown in lovely condition, moved out well

Brindle boy who is good for size and substance. Pleasing head on this male. Displays excellent forechest with well boned legs with strong pasterns and tight well padded feet. His body is firm & strong with well sprung ribs, correct topline and a strong well developed rear. Moved out well.

GRADUATE DOG

1st Ms J Davis's Bandit King of Hammerbarn at Rowanpaws

Brindle male on a smaller frame. Clean head properties with correct ear set, good open nostrils and square muzzle. Enough rib for size and correct topline with good tail. Would prefer neater feet on this boy, moved well once settled.

POST GRADUATE DOG

1st Miss S Suhareva & Mr J Cruttenden's – Castrum Osinium Roller Coaster at Avermayz JW (Imp CRO)

Ive judged this boy previously and still think he has a lot to like. lovely for size with excellent pigment. Square head with a kind expression, enough wrinkling, dark round expressive eyes, good cheeks and nostrils. Straight front with good pasterns and neat feet. Enough neck and well developed ribs, gently rounded at croup and enough angulation to rear with low set hocks, moved out well keeping a pleasing profile on the move.

2nd 1st Miss V Ross's Franstelgo's Low Rider

Brindle boy of pleasing size and substance displaying a balanced clean and proportionate head with no hint of coarseness. compact body which is balanced displaying good forechest and depth of rib. Rear quarters are correctly angulated with enough muscle tone. Good tail present, moved and handled well.

LIMIT DOG (4:1)

1st Ms K French's - Bincombefarm Morsmordre JW

Another I judged and previously awarded best puppy, my opinions on this smart boy still remain the same. He is a credit to his handler and pushed hard for a top spot today. Smart Brindle boy displaying good overall balance with sound construction. Clean proportionate head with dark eyes and neat bat ears which were well placed, clean muzzle displaying correct amount of padding, nice front with well boned legs and good feet, nice body proportions and in good condition, short tight coat, nice rear quarters which were well muscled, moved well to secure class win.

2nd Mr M Taylor's - Tytomax Celtic Warrior

Another brindle male with lovely head & expression, strong arched neck, nice straight front with good angulation to front showing good length of upper arm, Excellent well developed ribs, Correctly angulated rear with low set of hocks, turned out in excellent condition moved & handled to advantage.

3rd Ms C Jordan's Rowenpaws Comet Star

OPEN DOG

1st Ms L Brooks's Serenant Maverick

Another male I really admired previously as a youngster and he fulfilled my expectations of him today. He is so typical of class clown and really demands your attention. A showman who doesn't take himself too seriously. strong masculine head displaying a kind and alert expression. Bat ears used at all times with flat skull and soft wrinkling, strong cheeks and square clean muzzle. Strong, clean arched neck leading onto correct well laid shoulders, excellent straight front, strong pasterns and super tight feet. Fabulous forechest, good depth of brisket and well sprung ribs with plenty of lung and heart room. Nice taper to loin with strong angulated rear quarters in excellent hard condition displaying second thigh and hocks set low. Good topline and tail set, all this enabling this boy to move out with easy free and flowing movement, and he really can move. So pleasing on the eye. Pleased to award him CC.

She has a wonderful square head with well set ears and soft wrinkling, dark round eyes and wonderful clean under jaw. Clean arched neck onto well laid shoulders, straight front, good pasterns and neat feet. Forechest coming along nicely, good depth and spring of rib, short loin and low set tail. Enough angulation to rear with good covering allowing her to cover the ground freely. I will watch this classes future with interest. BPB.

2nd Mrs L Poulson - Aldhammill's Madammoiselle At Patchdown

Another super feminine brindle girl with many of the qualities of one, slightly lighter in frame today but I'm sure this will come in time. Clean neck and good shoulders, square in body and well angulated front and rear. Moved out well once settled.

11 month old brindle girl who I really like for substance and size. Very pleasing head properties with no coarseness. Good neck, enough rib and top line held well on the move. Low set tail and in good condition throughout. Coming along lovely at this age.

2nd - Mrs E Kelly's Casemates Dream Maker. Fawn girl, Pretty balanced head displaying correct bat ears with round well placed eyes and good underjaw. Clean straight front with enough bone and substance. Her body is maturing nicely for her age displaying a correct topline & underline. Pleasing top line and low set tail, her rear is strong and well angulated enabling this girl to move out with ease and kept together with her lovely conditioning. A real honest frenchie girl who pushed hard today.

2nd Mr K Greenall's - Princess Z Naszej Bajki At Manolta (imp Pol)

Another pleasing brindle girl who has lots to like. Super clean head, alert bat ears, the darkest of eye, good until and square muzzle displaying clean under jaw. Nice front with tight feet and good pigment. Square in body and in lovely condition. Sound and free movement.

Pretty girl to be appreciated for type. Good bone and substance. Lovely balanced head with good padding to muzzle and flat cheeks with correct ear placement. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulders with good angulation to front and rear. Moved well and shown in good condition with tight short coat.

Pretty brindle girl who is very typical for size and type. Nice feminine head which is very well balanced, correct mouth and good underjaw. Nice body proportions with good width of chest straight front, good spring of rib and nice taper to loin with a well set tail. Moved and handled well and kept in lovely condition.
